Eastern and Western traditions are merged and new directions in Asian brush art are explored in "Transformations of Brush and Paper," currently on display at BlackRock Center for the Arts in Germantown.

In the exhibit, Kit-Keung Kan animates suspended scrolls with large-scale calligraphy based on ancient Chinese scripts, Freda Lee-McCann applies layers of rice paper to transform brushwork influenced by traditional Chinese landscape painting, and In-soon Shin uses Hanji mulberry
