Singer/songwriter Victoria Vox, widely known for her work on the ukelele, will be joined by the Unified Jazz Ensemble Saturday at BlackRock Center for the Arts in celebration of the release of her new album "When Night Unravels."

These local favorites — Vox, based in Baltimore, and the Annapolis-based Unified Jazz Ensemble — will play an evening of jazz standards and original compositions.

She went on to earn a degree in songwriting from the Berklee College of Music (2001), then at 24 she was given a ukulele and never looked back. The small four-stringed instrument proved to be an excellent vehicle for her songwriting, while not getting in the way of her endearing vocals and seemingly simple, but rather smart songs.
