



## BlackRock Camp Rules and Regulations Form

1. To assure the safety of each child, all parents (carpool/ adult) are required to sign their student in and out each day. **No parking lot drop-offs allowed.** Please see attendance and pick up policy in camp and extended day handbook.
2. Campers are required to stay with their assigned counselors and teachers during the program day. Any attempt to leave the building unattended by a parent or guardian will result in immediate dismissal from the camp program.
3. BlackRock campers should abide by the stated behavior policies located in the camp handbook.
4. The following are consequences (in succession) for inappropriate behavior during camp:
  - 1st Warning, 2nd Warning, time out (for younger campers), loss of privilege, conference/talk with parents, loss of part or participation in show /camp (NO REFUNDS). BlackRock Center for the Arts reserves the right to excuse a child from camp due to repeated inappropriate behavior.
5. Campers should wear comfortable clothes and must wear only closed toe shoes. All campers may be asked to wear or bring certain items according to registered camp. Please see the "What to Bring to Camp" in the handbook.
6. Campers cannot bring any items (toys, games, mp3 players etc.) from home unless otherwise instructed to do so. If a camper must carry a cell phone, please leave it turned off, or in silent mode, for the duration of the camp day. If this is not adhered to, teachers reserve the right to confiscate the phone until the end of the day. BlackRock is not responsible for any loss of property.
7. Campers must bring a bag lunch each day. No peanut products and no microwaveable meals are permitted. If a student brings a lunch containing peanuts, parents will be notified and asked to bring a different lunch to the student. We encourage participants in the Extended Day program to bring a snack. No food will be provided by BlackRock.
8. Auditions will take place during the first week of the Performance Art Camp. BlackRock considers all of our campers to be equal and important. Every camper will have much to do in many scenes of the play. **NO REFUNDS ARE GIVEN FOR DISSATISFACTION OF A ROLE.**
9. Visitors (friends, family, members, etc...) are not allowed to attend or observe camp until the end of week Sharing or Performance.
